Goals and missions

- 1. To promote popularization of basketball between girls, accordingly motivating them to take part into basketball or activities connected with basketball.
- 2. To establish winners of MOLTEN cup 2015 in team basketball for girls at U-15(2000/2001) and U-13(2002/2003) age groups.
- 3. To promote the individual development of girls basketball teams and players, to ensure quality and competitive international game praxis.
 - 4. To promote ensuring high level of quality games.
 - 5. To promote the professional growth of youth basketball referees.
 - 6. To promote the professional growth of youth basketball coaches.
 - 7. To create a positive image of girls basketball.

I. Organizing of competitions

Molten cup contest in basketball for girls (hereinafter in the text - Molten Cup) is organized by Latvian Youth Basketball League (hereinafter in text – LYBL).

II. Participants of Molten cup

1. During season 2014/2015, championship passes between 2 age groups of girls:

> U-15 age group 2000/2001 year of birth U-13 age group 2002/2003 year of birth

III. 6th MOLTEN cup's time

Molten cup for U-15 and U-13 groups of girls takes place from 9th of January, 2015 till 11th of January 2015.

IV. Molten cup's general regulations

- 1. Molten cup contest occurs by FIBA regulation.
- 2. Additional regulation for Molten cup contest:
- 2.1. game time for U-15, U-13 age groups is 4 x 8 minutes;







- 2.2. foul rule: for each age group, each quarter 4 fouls (starting from 5th foul, foul shots are being performed);
 - 2.4. for U-15 age group games are played with 6th size balls and high baskets;
 - 2.5. for U-13 age group games are played with 5th size ball and high baskets
- 2.6. Age groups U-15 and U-13 age group there is permitted any zone defense and any zone pressing, it is only allowed to cover a person – person defense.

If a team fails any of the restriction mentioned in this paragraph, the coach of that team is warned after the first trespass, but after each next trespass, receives a technical foul, which is being recorded as a team's technical foul;

- 2.7. all games of Molten cup contest for U-15 and U-13 age groups are played with leather Molten balls;
- 2.11. at all age groups for each game in team line-up (game protocol) there can be applied 14 players and 3 persons from maintenance staff (coach, manager, doctor).
- 2.12. in case of a standoff result at U-15 and U-13 age groups, 3 minutes extra time follows.

V. Registration of participants

1. Teams application for participation at tournament

1.1. Sports schools/clubs teams applications for 2015 6th Molten Cup contest must be submitted in LYBL till 1st of December, 2014 by e-mail to: edijs@LBS.lv

VI. Competitions procedure and lead order

- 1. Molten cup contest at each age group occurs for 3 days,
- 2. Depending on number of teams applied, the system of lead is created.
- 3. Teams for Molten cup contest are divided by principle of draw.
- 4. Each team guaranteed 5 games in tournament.
- 5. Latvian best teams take participation in tournament.

VII. Financing of competition

- 1. <u>Team Participation fee for Molten cup is 100 Euro per team.</u>
- 2. Player participation fee for Molten cup:
- Player participation fee is 5 euro
- one feeding: is 5 euro
- one night accommodation: is 10-15 euro(depend from hotel)
- All teams are staying in Hotel or University Hotel







VIII. Awarding

- 1. All teams, that participate in contest, receives prizes given by the sponsor - sports inventory.
- 2. All players get tournament T-shirt
- 2. Winning teams at each age group receives a Molten cup and gifts from event sponsors.
